

Working method Reopening Circuit during Corona Crisis

1. Introduction

When the federal government as well as the local government allow certain sports activities to take place, it should be possible to reopen our circuit for training as well. In any case, this will be at the earliest on 12 May next (regardless of whether the government would even allow an earlier opening).

In order for this to take place in an orderly way, we will have to comply with the necessary regulations.

2. Number of riders

The total number of pilots that can be present on the track will be limited to 20 drivers. There will be a maximum of 60 pilots on the motocross circuit (20 young riders on the small circuits, and 2 x 20 riders on the GP Circuit). The riders who are registered to ride on the GP Circuit will be divided into 2 groups. The first group will ride from 13.00 till 16.00 hrs and the second group from 16.00 till 19.00 hrs.

Each motocross rider may be accompanied by a maximum of 1 extra person. This extra person can help in case of motorcycle problems or injuries. The accompanying person must be mentioned at registration and must always be the same person.

3. Registration

In order to avoid a overrun, we will opt to work with a pre-registration. Only persons who have registered and who have received confirmation of this registration by e-mail, will be admitted to the site. The board will strictly supervise that only persons with the correct papers have access to our facilities.



The registration will be done by mail. Drivers should send an e-mail to info@motorcrosscentrumlommel.be . In order to give everyone the chance to practice their favourite sport, the board will make sure that everyone can only train once a week (from Tuesday to Sunday). Registrations can be made 3 days in advance. E.g. to drive on the 14th of May, this can be requested as from the 11th of May 00.00 hrs. Registrations will be processed according to date and time of arrival on our mailserver. Knowing this, everyone has the same chance to register for a certain moment. The board will make every effort to confirm the registration within 2 hours (positive or negative). When requesting, please indicate clearly which day is desired and also the desired time span. This registration is a reservation of a timeslot. No advance payment will be requested but we do expect that the registered persons will inform the board as soon as possible should they be prevented by circumstances from driving at the permitted time, so that this place can be handed over to another candidate.

4. Payment

Payments will be made as usual when entering the porter's premises. In order to protect our employees as much as possible, they are obliged to wear gloves and a mouth mask.

Payment should preferably be made electronically (bancontact, maestro, mastercard, visa).

If this is not possible, then with appropriate money in an envelope.

5. Queue and Parking

Before people enter the car park, it is conceivable that there will be a queue of cars outside the gate. On the outside of the crosscircuit, signs will be placed that will make it compulsory to wait in the car to enter the car park. So it is not the intention that people get out of the queue to have a chat.

In order to guarantee sufficient distance between the drivers, the car park will be arranged in such a way that each car park is at least 4 metres wide.



For this purpose it is necessary that the engine is placed in front or behind the car, camper. Certainly not along the car, so that the width of 4 meters is used optimally.

The parking in front of the GP Circuit will be divided into 2 zones. When entering the terrain, the participants of the 1st session will have to park immediately to the left. The participants of the 2nd session will have to drive to the right when entering the terrain. Follow the instructions on information boards.

The youth drivers can immediately drive to the small track and get up there taking into account the necessary 4 meters distance.

Our superintendents will make sure that everyone respects a distance of at least 1.5 meters in the provided car park. Since the authorities are also very strict in this respect, offenders will be removed and denied access to the site in the future.

For the 1st session, the gate will be open from 12 o'clock. For the 2nd session, the gate will be open from 3 pm onwards.

In order not to have too many people on the terrain, the participants of the 1st session are kindly requested to leave the terrain before 5 pm.

6. Hygiene

On the grounds there is the possibility to wash your hands with ordinary soap. This can be done in the toilets.

Here, too, the necessary distances must be kept. In concrete terms, this means that only 1 person may be present in the toilet area and one must wait outside until the space is free.

For the time being we do not provide alcoholic gels to disinfect the hands so we kindly but urgently ask you to provide these gels yourself.



7. Sanitary facilities

During these measures, sanitary facilities will be reduced. For example, only one person per sanitary block will have access to the toilet. Even if there are several separate toilets, only one person will be admitted. These toilets will be marked outside in case there is a queue. SHOWERS WILL REMAIN CLOSED

8. Canteen

The canteen will remain closed until further notice and can only be opened at the earliest if the federal government authorises the catering industry to open it.

In view of the extreme circumstances, we ask everyone for their voluntary cooperation and understanding of this strict protocol. Of course, we will be forced to punish infringements very severely so that benevolent athletes would not be punished if the government were to oblige us to close the premises again for failure to comply with the rules imposed.
